

Above anything else, antivirus software must be capable of high detection rates. Command AntiVirus delivers, detecting 100% of ITW viruses and 99.30% of Zoo viruses according to testing performed by the experts at AV-Test.org. Command has also resisted temptation to play with it's straightforward interface, providing a consistent and friendly user experience. In fact, though Command provides full features, it is one of the easiest programs to operate, making it ideally suited for both the home and enterprise user.

Installation is straightforward, with options available to deselect certain features if desired. For example, DVP, Command's realtime scanning component, can be disabled during installation if a manual scanner is all that is required. An opportunity is presented to create rescue disks during setup. Don't worry if you don't have floppies on hand - Command provides the same option in the program interface for post-installation creation.

As a habitual scanner of all downloaded files (or those received via email), right-click scanning is at the top of my list of desired features. While nearly all antivirus products offer right-click scanning, Command's is one of the better ones. The feature is available for any file, regardless of type or whether it is included or excluded in the main scanner. Additionally, the scan launches quickly, focusing just on the file(s) chosen without wasting time or resources on memory scans or simply launching a dialog box which needs to be configured. While this may seem a petty feature, a streamlined right-click scanning feature makes scanning downloaded files painless and thus ensures it will be done consistently.

While other products feature automatic updating, Command's requires that the program be launched and the Update Deffiles button selected. This is actually a good feature for those with dial-up or non-persistent Internet connections. A warning will be issued when definition files are out of date, alerting users to the need to update.

Command AntiVirus provides the ability to add additional file types for scanning, or exclude specified files or directories. The settings are global, affecting the on-demand, scheduled, and on-access scanners, simplifying the configuration task. Command is not fooled by renamed or appended extensions, making scanning of files guarantined by other products a breeze.

Available for Microsoft® Windows 95/98, 2000/XP, and ME, with an install size averaging 7Mb and low performance overhead, Command AntiVirus is an excellent choice for both older or newer systems and experienced or novice users.
